If the client is moving somewhere within Arizona, Meyer will visit the new home to do measurements and will be on-site the move-in date and not leave her client's home until every box is unpacked, the frames are hung and the beds are made, leaving the home looking as if its already been lived in for a month. At this point the clients will have nothing to do but readjust to their new surroundings and smoothly transition into their new location. During the moving process, Meyer admits that she gets rather close

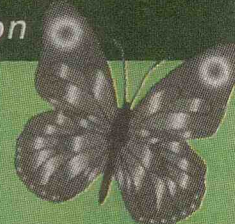
to her clients and will even visit them in their new homes from time to time, maintaining the relationship that she started with the organizational process.
